

# As Good As New

Time takes its toll on many things around the house. Match the old item below with a trick for making it look brand new again.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Copper pots and pans
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Bathroom tiles
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Leather furniture
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Fluffy bath towels
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Cloudy car headlights
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Toothbrush
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Scuffed leather shoes
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. White canvas sneakers

- a. Scrub with toothpaste using an old toothbrush. Polish with a soft cloth.
- b. Scrub with a solution of one teaspoon of dishwasher detergent, three tablespoons of hydrogen peroxide, and two tablespoons of baking soda.
- c. Wipe the scratches with olive oil using a cotton swab.
- d. Sprinkle the surface with the salt, then pour a little bit of vinegar on it. Rub with a hard sponge.
- e. Remove marks with fingernail polish remover.
- f. Pour boiling hot water in a bowl and swirl the brush around in it.
- g. Clean between them with a solution of equal parts water and bleach.
- h. Rinse them in salt water after laundering. Air dry.
