

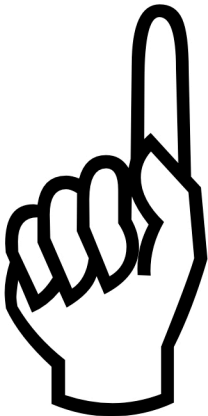
Tale of the Discouraged Disciple

John 21:1-14 tells the tale of Peter, the discouraged disciple, after he denied Jesus, and Jesus was crucified. Retell the story, using these picture cues.



Discouraged, Peter wanted to push the “*reset* button” and go back to his old life. How did that work out for him?

See John 21:1-5.



Peter was *reminded* of how his journey with Jesus began. How did that happen, and how did he react?

Compare John 21:6-9 to Luke 5:1-11.



As a result, the faith of Peter and the others was *recharged*.

Consider John 21:10-14 in light of John 6:1-13.
