Determining Value

If someone would like a tax deduction for items donated to charity, the U.S. Internal Revenue Service demands that donors calculate the value of those items.

Organizations such a Goodwill Industries compile lists of estimated values of commonly donated goods. It is assumed that the listed items are in good condition. http://www.goodwill.org/wp-content/uploads/2010/12/Donation_Valuation_Guide.pdf
