

# Outline Repair

Paul used his own experiences to explain to the church in Philippi what it meant to press on—to expend one’s effort in following Jesus. His words to the Philippians are consistent with his letters written to other churches.

Complete the lesson outline by reading the Scripture passages below that come from other letters Paul wrote. Put them in their proper places in the outline to show how they relate to Paul’s testimony about his life.

- I. Reject EMPTY ACHIEVEMENTS (Philippians 3:7, 8a).
